Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander artists are invited to submit artwork for the North Queensland Toyota Cowboys 2019 Indigenous Jersey Design Competition. The competition is a chance for talented Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander artists (aged 15 years and older) and their winning artwork to be recognised across Australia.

The winning artwork will be used to create the North Queensland Cowboys 2019 Indigenous Jersey. The winning artist will receive \$2,500; 4 tickets seated in the Eastern Grandstand and a car park pass to all of the home games in the 2018 North Queensland Toyota Cowboys season, and a 2018 Indigenous Jersey.

Your artwork must reflect North Queensland Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander cultures and the North Queensland Toyota Cowboys' Club values.

All entries must be accompanied by a signed and completed Entry Form including design story and received by 5pm, Friday 2 March 2018. Entry limit of one entry per artist. No late entries will be considered.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The artwork must reflect both Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander cultures preferably in North Queensland.
2. All participating artists must:
 - Be of Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander descent; and
 - Identify as an Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander; and
 - Be accepted as an Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander in their community.All participating artists must be 15 years and over; participating artists under 18 years must have a parent/guardians permission to enter into the completion.
3. All entries will be viewed by and judged by a panel of the North Queensland Cowboys Indigenous Players.
4. The artist is to submit only one artwork entry via Email: community@cowboys.com.au with an attached digital photo of the artwork or post, with all entries being accompanied by a signed Entry Form.
5. The winning artist acknowledges their artwork will be copied and reproduced for the purposes of the North Queensland Cowboys 2018 Indigenous Jersey and Community Relations programs. The winning artist will be required to supply an original copy of their design for reproduction.
6. No group entries will be accepted.
7. The artwork dimensions should measure: A3 size or no larger than 60cm X 60cm. Artwork should not be framed or mounted behind glass.
8. All participating artists warrant that they are 15 years and older at the time the Entry Form is submitted; the artwork submitted is original work; the artwork submitted has not been the recipient of a major prize before; and that they have not charged or otherwise encumbered the work nor given any assignment inconsistent with these Terms and Conditions. Where a participating artist is under the age of 18, the artist's adult parent/guardian must complete the Entry Form by stating their own name on behalf of the artist.
9. An award of \$2,500; 4 Platinum memberships seated in the Eastern Grandstand and a car park pass for all home games in the North Queensland Toyota Cowboys 2019 season; and a 2019 Indigenous Jersey will be given to the winning artist. Entry to 1300SMILES Stadium is subject to Terms and Conditions.
10. The decision of the judges will be final and absolute. No correspondence about the decision will be entered into.
11. Property rights in all submissions, including the winning artwork, will remain the artists except as provided by these Terms and Conditions.
12. By signing a completed Entry Form, submitting an artwork and accepting the award offer, the winning artist grants the North Queensland Cowboys a permanent, royalty-free, worldwide, irrevocable, ongoing, non-exclusive licence, including a right of sub-licence to use, reproduce, distribute, adapt, modify the winning artwork in all media of expression now known or later developed for the purpose or any other purpose associated with the North Queensland Cowboys and other Indigenous engagement initiatives, including but not limited to, reproducing and publishing the winning entry of the official 2019 North Queensland Cowboys Indigenous Jersey Design Competition, for any other event, educational purpose or activity:
 - Consent to any of the following types of acts or omissions by the North Queensland Cowboys: (a) use of all or part of the artwork in accordance with the licence granted above, with or without attribution of authorship to the artist. (b) supplementing the artwork with any other material; and (c) use of the artwork in a different context to that originally envisaged;
 - Warrants that there is no cultural or religious reason or any other impediment that prevents the winning artwork from being exhibited, published or reproduced.
13. All entries must be received by 5pm on Friday 2 March 2018.
14. The North Queensland Toyota Cowboys may amend these Terms and Conditions from time to time, and any amendment will be binding to all entrants. If, for any reason, the competition is not able to be run as planned the North Queensland Cowboys may cancel the Indigenous Jersey Design Competition without liability to any entrant, or any other person.
15. The North Queensland Cowboys is the Promoter of this North Queensland Cowboys competition.
16. The North Queensland Cowboys reserves the right, at any time, to verify the validity of participating artist, artwork and Entry Form (including participating artist's identity, age and place of residence) and to disqualify a participating artist who submits an Entry Form that is not in accordance with these Competition Terms and Conditions or who tampers with the entry process
