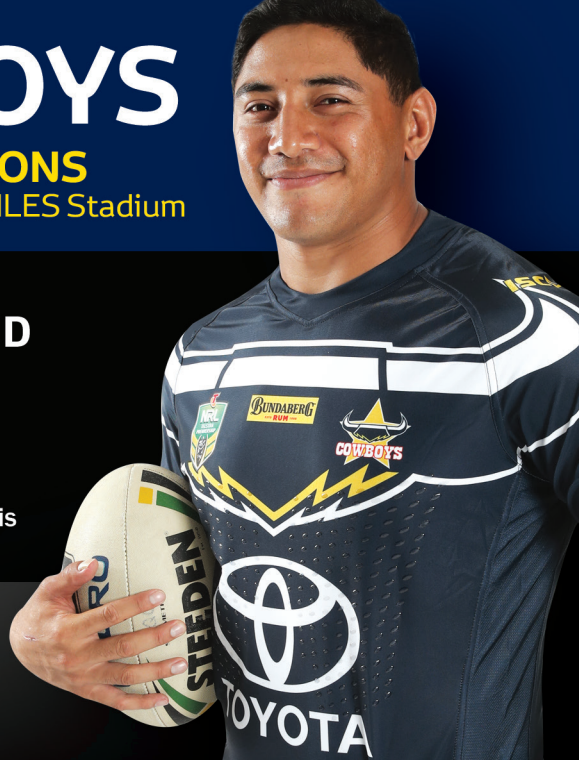

# Terms and conditions of entry - “Toyota Cowboys Coach for a Day”

1. Instructions and information on how to enter form part of the Full Terms and Conditions of Entry (Conditions of Entry). Participation in this competition constitutes acceptance of these Conditions of Entry.

2. Entry is open to Australian residents who purchase and take delivery of any new Toyota vehicle at a participating Toyota dealership in North Queensland during June 2018. Directors, management and the employees of the Promoter and agencies, retailers and suppliers associated with this promotion and the immediate family members of these people are ineligible to enter.

3. The competition starts on 1 June 2018 and ends on 30 June 2018. All new Toyota vehicles that are sold, registered and delivered to eligible private and ABN customers at participating dealers during the competition period are eligible for the promotion.

4. To enter: Purchase and take delivery of any new Toyota vehicle from a participating North Queensland Toyota dealership between 1 June and 30 June 2018 and you will automatically go in the draw. Only private and bronze fleet purchases are eligible.

5. The prize draw will take place at the Toyota Regional Office, 20 Paradise Road, Acacia Ridge Queensland on 2 July 2018 at 11:00am. The first valid entry randomly drawn from all entries will win the major prize. The winner will be contacted by their local Toyota dealer. If a winning entry is invalid, that entry will be discarded and the prize will be awarded by drawing another entry in accordance with these Conditions of Entry.

6. Prize: The winner will be taken on the Round 19, 21 July 2018, weekend for the NRL game, NQ Cowboys versus the Dragons at 1300SMILES Stadium, Townsville. The winner plus one guest will be entitled to: ‘Money can’t buy’ tour prior to the game (includes tour of training facilities, gym, dressing room and pre-match briefing by a member of the coaching staff), be escorted to your facilities for the game, enjoy hospitality (food and drinks) from the North Queensland Toyota Cowboys – first half, sit sideline with Football Manager and support staff – second half, visit dressing room and attend post-match media conference, post-match presentations at the Cowboys Leagues Club

The Cowboys may, in its absolute discretion, withdraw the prize (or any elements of the prize), if it believes the prize winner and/or their guest (or any permitted replacements) breach the Code of Conduct or otherwise cause an unacceptable disruption to the match.
